ABOUT ART THERAPY

The Art Therapy program at Shirley Ryan AbilityLab is based on the belief that the creative process facilitates mind-body connection and assists patients in exploring intense emotions accompanying the rehabilitation process. It encourages self-expression, reduces stress and anxiety, and promotes healing and self-awareness.

Individual and group art therapy sessions focus on building resiliency through the promotion of self-esteem and functional independence. Patients explore new possibilities to approach their lives and discover strengths through adaptation of art materials. They are able to engage in art with the highest level of independence and find freedom in the artistic process.

ART THERAPY BENEFITS PATIENTS BY:

- Increasing emotional adjustment to disability and managing anxiety and depression related to changes in functioning.
- Creating a space and time for patients to mourn their losses, come to term with the impact of illness on their physical and psychological functioning.
- Providing a non-verbal means of communications for patients who may not be able to express themselves otherwise.
- Enhancing fine motor skills and coordination.
