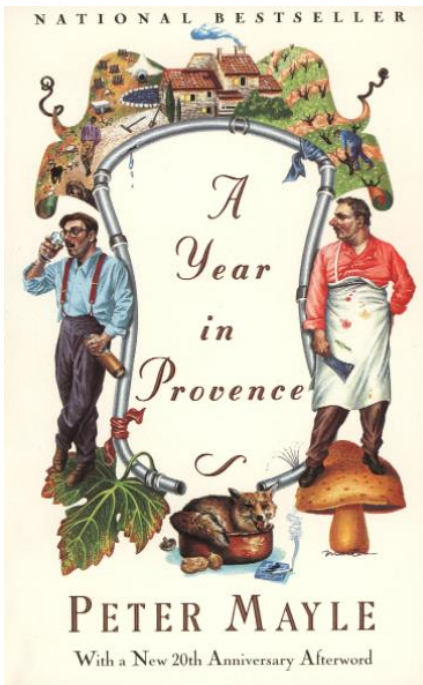

## **My Year in Provence**

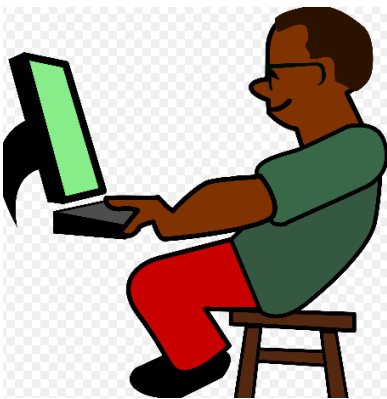
**by Peter Mayle**
